1. The total value of the NRRP in Italy is: € 191.5 bn

"Italy will have a more efficient and digitized public administration. Italian citizens will benefit from more modern, sustainable and widespread transport. The investments and reforms included in Italia Domani will make the country more territorially cohesive, with a more dynamic labour market and without gender or age discrimination. Public health will be more modern and closer to people. Italia Domani is part of Next Generation EU, an economic recovery project dedicated to member states





- 2. The Cross Priorities of the Plan The cross priorities underpin the investments, reforms and projects under the Plan and have the stated goal of reducing disparities among regions, generations and genders in Italy:
- **2.A YOUTH** Invest in the new generations to guarantee access to childcare, improve the school system and reverse the country's declining birth rate
- **2. B- GENDER EQUALITY** Reform, educate and invest to ensure women and men have equal social and economic opportunities
- **2. C REDUCE THE GAPS IN STANDARDS OF LIVING -** Bridge the citizenship gap by realising the potential of the South and enhancing local services to support the disabled and elderly.





The Plan in Missions (6 Missions)

1. Digitalisation, innovation, competitiveness, culture and tourism – Focus on Digitalisation of Public Administration: Transform Public Administration, making it simpler for citizens and businesses by reducing time and costs and contributing to the creation of new jobs.

2. Green revolution and ecological transition - A deep change to achieve Italy's green and ecological transition by promoting the circular economy, the development of renewable energy sources and more sustainable agriculture.



A new educational system that places young people at the forefront, to guarantee them the right to study, as well as the skills and abilities necessary to meet the challenges of the future.




